*Must have at least one leader of each gender for youth groups

Cost:

\$95 per head + cost of project

*Includes meals & lodging

What to bring:

- Bible, pen, journal
- Work clothes
- Warm clothes for evenings
- Swim suits – Knee length shorts for guys & one piece suits for girls
- Close-toed, comfortable shoes*
- Long pants*
- Work gloves
- Sandals
- Sleeping bag, pillow, blanket
- Personal hygiene supplies
- Sunscreen & bug spray
- Camp Chair
- Spending money for Cedar Creek

*These are required for some projects

What NOT to bring:

- Drugs or alcohol (including tobacco & marijuana)
- Guns, slingshots, explosives or other weapons (small pocket knives are allowed)
- Ipods, radios, MP3 players, etc.
